SEDATION

• You will be receiving IV (Intravenous) sedation. You <u>MUST</u> have an adult companion (family member or a friend) to take you home. You are <u>NOT</u> allowed to drive or leave the Endoscopy Center alone.

DAILY MEDICATIONS

- If you are taking blood thinners (ex: Coumadin, Plavix, Eliquis, Xarelto) you must **<u>STOP</u> taking** them with the consent from your prescribing physician starting on this
 - Coumadin STOP 5 days before procedure and take Lovenox as directed
 - Plavix STOP 5 days before procedure
 - Eliquis/Brilinta/Xarelto STOP 1 day before procedure
- You may take your asthma and blood pressure medications with small sips of water the morning of the procedure.
- If you use an inhaler for your asthma, bring it with you the day of your procedure.
- If you have diabetes, **<u>DO NOT</u>** take Insulin or diabetic pill on the day of your procedure.
- If you are taking diet pills (Phentermine, Metermine, Elvenir, Fastin, etc.), you must <u>STOP</u> taking them 14 days before your procedure.
- If you take iron pills or fiber supplements. You must <u>STOP</u> taking them one week before your procedure... starting on DATE:.

JEWELRY & VALUABLES

- Please do not bring any valuable items or jewelries to the endoscopy room for your procedure.
- Nose, lip, or tongue jewelry piercings should be removed.

CLEAR LIQUID DIET

- Consists of clear liquids or foods that turn to liquids at room temperature.
- The purpose of clear liquid diet is mainly to provide rest to your gastrointestinal tract prior to your colonoscopy procedure, and to ensure adequate visibility for the procedure. It is capable of keeping you hydrated.

1. You will be given a prescription for a laxative called **SUTAB** (or a generic form).

	Begin a Clear Liquid diet this AM and continue throughout the day.

	Step 1: Open 1 bottle of 12 tablets. Fill the provided container with 16
	ounces of water (up to the fill line). Swallow each tablet with a sip of water,
	and drink the entire amount of water over 15 to 20 minutes.
	Step 2: Approximately 1 (ONE) hour after the last tablet is ingested, fill the
	provided container again with 16 ounces of water (up to fill line), and drink
	the entire amount over 30 minutes.
	Step 3: Approximately 30 minutes after finishing the second container of
	water, fill the container with 16 ounces of water, and drink the entire
	amount over 30 minutes.
